of the
FIT Committee for Legal Translation and Court
Interpreting

The organization of the 10th FIT CLTCI International Forum has been the most important activity during the period under review (i.e. May 2010- February 2011). The Forum, which be held in Paris, France, from 19 through 21 May will be devoted to Ethics and Good Practices. The UNETICA association and the Institut Supérieur d'Interprétation et de Traduction (ISIT) have been most generously and efficiently helping to organize the event. UNETICA has allowed the organizers to use their website www.unetica.fr for placing information about the Forum. To date, almost 30 participants have registered.

The organizers were successful in inviting Mr. Wolter Witteveen from the Directorate General for Interpretation for the European Commission.

The Committee's initiative to create the bank of information on the status of legal translation and court interpreting (LTICI) worldwide has not as yet received much support. The CLTCI had received only one contribution from Uruguay which was subsequently withheld.

The CLTCI Co-Chairs assisted the FIT Congress organizers' in reviewing abstracts for the Congress in San Francisco.

Taking the opportunity, the CLTCI requests the Council's decision to provide a quick link on the FIT home page to the Paris CLTCI Forum.
